Since we were established in 2001, the Projects Consultancy has developed a range of expert services covering all stages of project development and implementation.

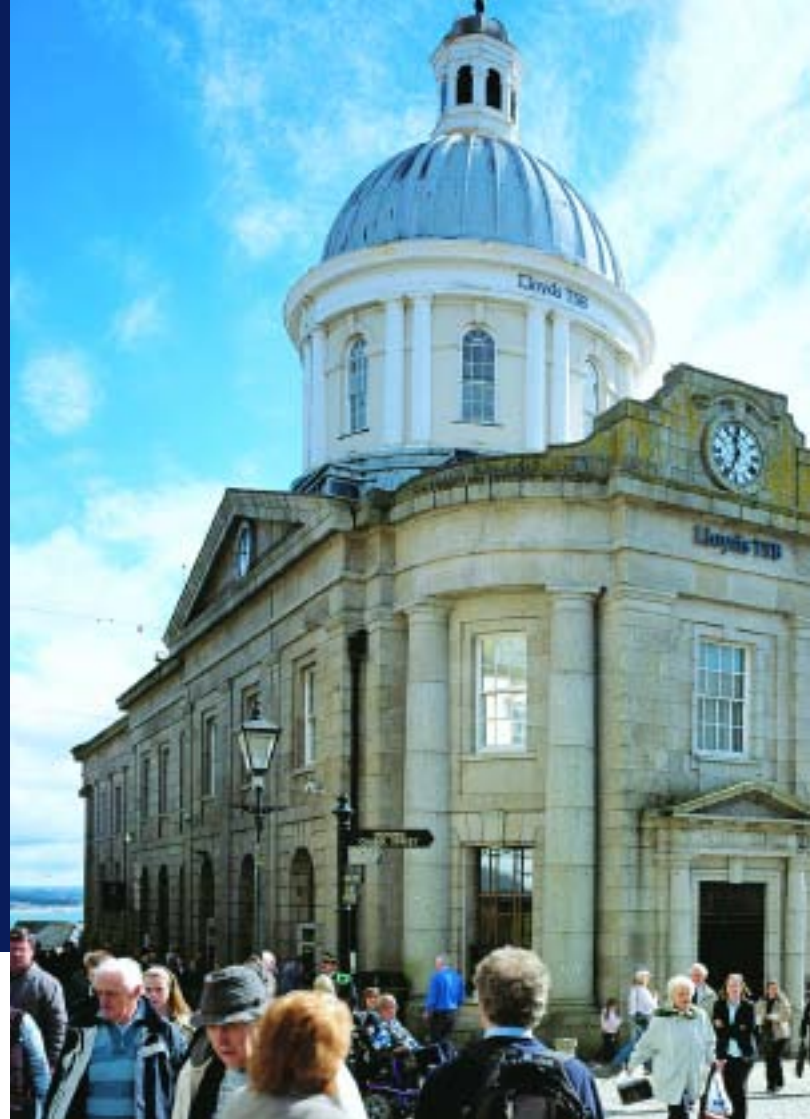
The Projects Consultancy has worked closely with Cornwall County Council to secure funding for improvements at Newquay Airport and to assist in developing plans for its future.

Our project staff work individually or in small teams, providing a flexible service tailored to fit client needs. This enables us to respond quickly to new initiatives and opportunities. In addition, our close working relationships with other services of Cornwall Enterprise and Cornwall County Council enable us to draw upon a very wide range of resources and expertise.

Cornwall Enterprise supports projects promoting renewable energy and sustainable development in Cornwall. The Projects Consultancy has secured funding from DEFRA and other sources for projects including ReMaDe Kernow, and the Cornwall Sustainable Tourism Project.
